## Part 1

- 1. Work in small groups.
- 2. Characterize the teacher in the story. Give as many details of him or her as you could get from the text. Do you like him or her as a character? Why? Would you like to have him or her a teacher? Why?
- 3. Describe the setting in which he or she teaches. How is it special? How may it relate to his or her attitude to teaching? How may it relate to the context of production of the short story?
- 4. Do you think that he or she teaches for social reproduction or for social change?

  What elements in the story would help you make your point?
- 5. Identify the climax of the story. What does it tell you about its main theme?
- 6. Re-read the end of the story. How is it particularly meaningful?
